Metal body control the lamination from rough surface. Adjustable temperature allow photo bubble free result. It just convenient with a reverse mechanism to clear accidental jam.

Performance Description

Hot Lamination: Use heat adhesives that is activated to the inner surface pouch which the material being laminated. A common types of laminations of 80 - 180 microns method used to apply on surface which do not have inks melt when exposed to high temperatures. Hot Laminations gives more precise quality, durable resistant lamination to wear and tear.

Cold Lamination: Used pressure "sticky" sensitive adhesives especially ink jet material to bind on the lamination film. This excellent options are good for schools, businesses and goverment agencies. (For example such as faxes, photos, and other materials printed with an ink jet printer.)

Steps:



Turn On/Off button wait for green ready button.



Put document inside the pouch against sealed edge. To prevent lamination jam, use a carrier cover the pouch when laminate.



Always laminate with the seal area into laminator to prevent paper jam & bubble.



Pouch will roll out from the back of the machine. After finish, let it cool on a flat surface for few seconds.

Caution: A

- Power source always installed near to the equipment and easied by accessible.
- Do not leave power cord in contact with a warm surface, and use laminator while is damaged.
- Do not laminate thickness more then 300gm paper.
- Switch off and unplug the cable if not in use.

Tips:

- Always insert pouch with the close gap area to the laminator
- Don't laminated with an empty pouch, always put item in a pouch.
- To double protection your pouch while laminate, use paper to cover both side of the pouch.
- Do a test run before laminating valuable items
- Trim extra area after laminating and cooling.
